Percentage of teachers in publicly funded programs at or above the current state standard of level 7 increased from 76% in 2008 to 82% in 2009 to 86% in 2010. Those with a Bachelor degree or higher, which is the 2015 requirement, has steadily increased each year but still falls short of representing even 50% of the currently employed teachers in publicly funded programs. This increase is a direct result of more individuals requesting and receiving scholarship funding toward bachelor degree course work.
